ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE



TO OBTAIN SERVICE: 1-800-AAA-HELP

Your AAA membership includes four roadside assistance calls each membership year. AAA Idaho (“the Club”) reserves the right to limit service, not renew a membership, or cancel a membership at any time.

Roadside assistance will be sent to the disabled vehicle without charge from the nearest AAA contract station. You may receive service on any eligible vehicle you are in at the time the vehicle becomes disabled by presenting your AAA card at the time of service. Members are expected to be with the vehicle at the time of service. **Please see the Roadside Assistance Details section on page 14 for additional information.**

PLEASE NOTE: AAA services are generally provided by independent businesses under contract to AAA Idaho (except where service is provided by the Club-owned fleet). These independent contractors are not agents or employees of the Club. Any claim for damage to the property or person of the member should be filed with the facility that provided the service. At the request of a member, AAA Idaho will assist you in resolving complaints against independent contract facilities.

ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE BENEFITS

AAA Roadside Assistance is not intended as a substitute for proper maintenance of your vehicle. In fairness to all AAA Idaho members, the Club cannot render service repeatedly to a vehicle in need of repair.

Members requiring more than four road service calls during a membership year will be sent service but will be charged for the fifth and each subsequent call. Charges for additional calls will be at special AAA member rates. You will be billed by the Club. Failure to pay the surcharge may result in non-renewal or cancellation of your membership. For other limitations please see pages 14-15.

ACCIDENT TOWING

If you are involved in an accident, simply notify AAA and a service vehicle will be dispatched to assist you in accordance with the towing and extrication provisions. If the service provider who arrives on the scene was not dispatched by AAA, or if you are unable to remain at the scene, you may apply for reimbursement consideration. AAA may subsequently seek reimbursement from insurance companies and/or repair facilities.



AAA BATTERY SERVICE

AAA Battery Service provides a mobile, convenient testing and jump start service to get you going again. Our AAA Battery Service Technicians can safely and accurately diagnose your battery’s condition at your convenience. If your battery is dead, we will provide a jump start. If the vehicle will not start, towing will be provided. In some service areas the technician can install, at an additional cost to you, a new battery on site if you so choose.

AAA Battery Service includes:

- Battery and electrical system testing, at no additional cost
- Qualified technicians committed to distinguished member service and customer satisfaction
- An exclusive member price on a AAA-branded battery with a 3-year full replacement warranty valid throughout North America

If a AAA battery is purchased, the call will not count against your four call annual limit on roadside assistance calls.

Battery Service is available to all members, although battery purchase and installation may not be available in all locations. The cost of purchasing a new battery is the responsibility of the member.

AAA Battery Service is generally provided by independent service providers. AAA batteries and battery warranties are provided by Club Assist U.S. LLC. AAA batteries are available for most vehicle makes and models. Copies of the warranties are available for inspection from the technician at any time upon request. Membership Roadside Assistance terms and conditions apply.

EMERGENCY TOWING

We will attempt to start your eligible vehicle and get you on the way. If attempts to start your vehicle are unsuccessful and your vehicle is unable to safely proceed under its own power, towing service will be provided:

- Back to the station providing towing service or any point of your choice along the direct return *or*
- To any point of safety within the city of the station providing towing service *or*
- To any point of safety within a ten-mile radius of the breakdown.



EXTRICATION/WINCHING

When a vehicle becomes stuck and can be safely reached from a normally traveled roadway, service will be provided by one truck and driver using normal automobile servicing equipment. When necessary, more operators or equipment will be provided at your expense. If the vehicle cannot be safely driven after winching, it may be towed.

FUEL DELIVERY

When a vehicle runs out of fuel, an emergency supply of fuel will be delivered to the member's disabled vehicle enabling the member to reach the nearest service station, or the vehicle will be towed to a facility where fuel is available. The Club cannot guarantee specific brands, octane ratings, or the availability of diesel fuel. If the vehicle will not start, towing may be provided. AAA Basic Members will be charged for fuel at current pump rates.

AUTO LOCKOUT SERVICE

If your keys are locked in the passenger compartment of the vehicle, the service technician will attempt to gain access. If the vehicle cannot be opened, it may be towed. If your keys are locked in the trunk, lost, broken, or the service provider cannot gain entry, AAA locksmith service or, if unavailable, reimbursement of up to \$50 will be provided. *See Reimbursement for Alternate Service on page 15 for additional details.*

MECHANICAL FIRST AID

Service covers minor adjustments (not requiring parts, materials, or supplies) that may enable your vehicle to safely proceed under its own power. If the adjustments do not make the vehicle operable, towing will be provided. Minor adjustments do not include the purchase and/or installation of parts (starters, alternators, etc.)

TIRE SERVICE

A flat tire will be inflated or replaced with your spare tire. If you do not have a spare, towing will be provided. *See Roadside Assistance Details on page 14 for additional details.*

BICYCLE SERVICE

AAA Idaho provides bicycle service to all membership levels. Bicycle service benefits and exclusions are different in several important ways than service benefits and exclusions for automobiles (or motorcycles which are only covered under AAA Plus or AAA Premier). Bicycle transportation service is counted towards your four roadside assistance service calls per member, per membership year. Bicycle service is provided only within the AAA Oregon/Idaho coverage area, which includes Oregon and the southern 34 counties of Idaho. *(Other details and limitations apply, see pages 14 and 15.)*



Eligible Bicycles

Service applies to all bicycles and tandems, including rental bicycles and bicycle trailers, if service can be safely delivered using normal servicing equipment.

Bicycle Repair

Service Vehicles are not equipped to repair a member's bicycle or change a flat tire; however, transportation for your disabled bicycle will be provided subject to the terms discussed herein.

Coverage to Bicycle Rider Only

Bicycle transportation service is provided only for the rider whose bicycle is disabled or inoperable.

To Obtain Service

A Roadside Assistance vehicle will be sent to the eligible disabled bicycle without charge from the nearest AAA contract station. Bicycle coverage applies to any eligible bicycle you

are riding at the time the bicycle becomes disabled. Simply present your valid AAA card at the time of service. Members are expected to be with the bicycle at time of service.

Disabled or Inoperable Bicycle

Coverage is provided to a member whose bicycle has become disabled or inoperable. If transportation of your disabled bicycle is required, service will be provided:

- Back to the station that dispatched transportation service or any point of choice along the direct return route *or*
- To any point of safety within the city of the station providing transportation service *or*
- To any point of safety within a 10-mile radius of the bicycle breakdown.

See *Roadside Assistance Details* on page 14 for additional details.

OTHER MEMBER SERVICES

ACCIDENT AWAY FROM HOME EXPENSE

In the event a member’s passenger automobile is disabled as a result of a collision, fire, theft, or vandalism, AAA will reimburse you up to a total of \$200 for certain unexpected expenses:

- Meals and lodging while your car is being repaired *or*
- Car rental from a licensed rental agency so that you can continue your trip or return home *or*
- Commercial transportation to your destination on a licensed common carrier of passengers.



The disablement of the vehicle must occur 50 miles or more from your home. The member must be with the vehicle at the time of disablement. Mechanical failures do not qualify. Reimbursement will be made for the largest single expense incurred by you and your traveling companion from the three different types of reimbursable expenses listed above. Reimbursement applies only to expenses incurred during the first three days following the disablement of the vehicle. For more information, contact the Special Services Department at 1-800-452-1643, ext. 6787.

\$1,000 THEFT REWARD

AAA membership offers protection of \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person(s) stealing a vehicle registered in the member’s name. Reward claim must be submitted within 60 days of conviction. Law enforcement officers, the member, and the member’s family are ineligible to receive the reward. Commercial vehicles and motorcycles are not covered.

REIMBURSEMENT OF ATTORNEY’S FEES

Your AAA Club is ready to assist you in your defense against a moving traffic violation you believe is unjust. Reimbursement for defense of attorney fees is made if you are arrested and tried for a motor vehicle violation received while driving a private passenger vehicle. **YOU MUST DENY THE CHARGE AND APPEAR WITH YOUR ATTORNEY AT THE TIME OF TRIAL TO BE ELIGIBLE.**

AAA membership entitles you to reimbursement of attorney’s fees in amounts not exceeding those listed in the schedule of payments. The amount of reimbursement is not intended to fix the fee charged by an attorney to defend you in court. This is a matter to be discussed between you and the attorney of your choice. You will choose your own attorney to conduct your defense.

WHAT REIMBURSEMENT COVERS:

1. For defense in negligent homicide or manslaughter cases,

not exceeding	\$500
If appealed, not more than an additional	\$500
TOTAL	\$1,000
2. For defense of reckless driving (but not applicable when charged with DUI), not exceeding

If appealed, not more than an additional\$100

TOTAL\$200

3. For defense of moving traffic violations, such as failure to yield right of way, speeding, driving through traffic signals, etc., not exceeding\$75

If appealed, not more than an additional\$75

TOTAL\$150

When more than one charge results from a single incident, reimbursement will be made for the trial charge calling for the largest payment. For more information, call 1-800-452-1643, ext. 6787.

No reimbursement will be made for crimes or offenses involving driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquors or drugs or narcotics, failure to appear on prior traffic violations, driving on a suspended or revoked driver's license, failure to perform the duties of a driver, hit-and-run, failure to present evidence of insurance, illegal use or falsification of license or registration, attempt to elude or eluding a police officer; equipment violation or any unlisted felony; for payment of fine or bail forfeiture; for defending personal injury or property damage suits (the defense of such cases should be covered by the member's own automobile policy); or after license has been suspended for failure to appear for the hearing at the time and place fixed by the court. Motorcycles and commercial vehicles are excluded from coverage.

PLEASE NOTE: AAA membership is not a contract of insurance.

AAA PLUS

There's a way to make your AAA benefits even stronger. AAA Plus is an optional plan that, when added to your Basic membership, gives you even more of AAA's valuable protection. See the Plus application or call your local Service Center to upgrade. AAA Plus gives you all the benefits of primary membership including these extended services:

UP TO 100 MILES OF TOWING

AAA Plus extends the Basic AAA towing benefits by providing up to 100 miles of towing in any direction from the point of disablement to a destination of the member's choice.

BICYCLE SERVICE

AAA Plus extends the Basic bicycle service benefits by providing up to 100 miles of bicycle transportation service in any direction from the point of disablement to a destination of the member's choice. Bicycle transportation service is counted towards your four roadside assistance service calls per member, per membership year.

UP TO \$100 FOR LOCKSMITH SERVICE

AAA Plus extends your present AAA locksmith service to a total of \$100 in parts and labor if such service is required either to gain access to the passenger compartment of the vehicle, to remove keys from the trunk, or to make the eligible vehicle drivable.

EXTENDED EXTRICATION SERVICE

AAA Plus extends your present Basic coverage to include the service of a second operator and second truck for one hour. If the vehicle is inoperable after extrication, the extended towing benefit will apply.

ACCIDENT AWAY FROM HOME EXPENSE

In the event a AAA Plus (or Plus RV) member's eligible vehicle is disabled as a result of a collision, fire, theft, or vandalism, AAA will reimburse you up to a total of \$500 for certain unexpected expenses:

- Meals and lodging while your car is being repaired or
- Car rental from a licensed rental agency so you can continue your trip or return home or
- Commercial transportation to your destination on a licensed common carrier of passengers.

The disablement of the vehicle must occur 50 miles or more from your home. The member must be with the vehicle at the time of disablement. Mechanical failures do not qualify. Reimbursement will be for the largest single expense incurred by you and accompanying spouse from the three different types of reimbursable expenses listed above.

Reimbursement applies only to expenses incurred during the first five days following the disablement of the vehicle. Reimbursement claims must be submitted within sixty (60) days of accident. For more information, call 1-800-452-1643, ext. 6787.

UP TO \$2,000 IN LEGAL REIMBURSEMENT

AAA Plus extends your present membership up to the following limits for reimbursement of attorney's fees for defense of vehicle-related charges to which you plead not guilty and appear at trial with your attorney in defense of such charges. AAA Plus covers any Plus Member who is driving a vehicle eligible for service under AAA Basic membership at the time such charges are incurred. Charges covered under this benefit are listed below and include reimbursement for appeal. When more than one charge results from a single incident, reimbursement will be made for the trial charge calling for the largest payment.

1. For defense in negligent homicide or manslaughter cases, not exceeding.....	\$1,000
If appealed, not more than an additional	\$1,000
TOTAL	\$2,000
2. For defense of reckless driving (but not applicable when charged with DUI), not exceeding.....	\$200
If appealed, not more than an additional	\$200
TOTAL	\$400
3. For defense of moving traffic violations, such as failure to yield right of way, speeding, driving through traffic signals, etc., not exceeding	\$150
If appealed, not more than an additional.....	\$150
TOTAL	\$300

No reimbursement will be made for crimes or offenses involving driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquors, drugs or narcotics, failure to appear on prior traffic violations or driving on a suspended or revoked driver's license, failure to perform the duties of a driver, hit-and-run, failure to present evidence of insurance, illegal use or falsification of license or registration, or attempt to elude or eluding a police officer; equipment violation or any unlisted felony; for payment of fine or bail forfeiture; for defending personal injury or property damage suits (the defense of such cases should be covered by the member's own automobile policy); or after license has been suspended for failure to appear for the hearing at the time and place fixed by the court. Motorcycles and commercial vehicles are excluded from coverage. For more information call 1-800-452-1643, ext. 6787.

\$300,000 IN TRAVEL ACCIDENT INSURANCE

AAA Plus includes up to \$300,000 in coverage for loss of life or limb when traveling by scheduled airline, ship, bus, or train when common carrier tickets are purchased through any AAA Travel Agency. The same coverage applies when traveling in a rental car arranged by AAA in connection with your scheduled airline or other common carrier travel purchased through AAA.

\$2,000 THEFT REWARD

AAA Plus extends your present Basic membership to include \$2,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person(s) stealing a vehicle registered in the member's name. Reward claims must be submitted within 60 days of a conviction. Law enforcement officers, the member, and the member's family are ineligible to receive this reward. Commercial vehicles and motorcycles are not covered.

AAA TRAVEL GUIDES AND MAPS

The AAA-published edition of *The Europe TravelBook*, and AAA-published maps of Europe are available to AAA Plus members at no additional charge.

MOTORCYCLE COVERAGE

AAA Plus coverage includes motorcycles licensed for use on public roads. *All other roadside assistance details and limitations apply.*

AAA PLUS RV

AAA Plus RV coverage can be added as an option to AAA Plus. When you need roadside assistance service for personal use of state licensed recreational vehicles including a motor home, travel trailer, pickup with camper, or a small trailer, horse trailer, boat trailer no longer than 26 feet in length used when transporting personal watercraft, snowmobiles, or motorcycles, or other state licensed recreational vehicle.

To upgrade to AAA Plus RV, call 1-800-JOIN-AAA, visit AAA.com or stop by your local Service Center. Please note, \$24 of the annual AAA Plus RV dues are non-refundable if you cancel your membership.

All other roadside assistance details and limitations apply.

AAA PREMIER

AAA Premier Members receive extended benefits beyond those in the Basic and Plus membership levels. For complete details, see the AAA Premier Membership Handbook, AAA.com/Premier or call your local Service Center to upgrade. AAA Premier gives you all the benefits of AAA Plus, and also includes the following:



200 MILE TOW*

AAA Premier Members receive four roadside assistance service calls per member, per membership year, one of which can be a tow of up to 200 miles. The remaining three tows available are up to 100 miles each. This benefit is different than that provided under AAA Plus. *PLEASE NOTE: Vehicles covered under Plus RV are not eligible for the 200 mile tow.*

BICYCLE SERVICE

AAA Premier extends the AAA Plus bicycle service benefits by providing one instance of bicycle transportation service of up to 200 miles, while the remaining three are up to 100 miles of bicycle transportation service in any direction from the point of disablement to a destination of the member's choice. Bicycle transportation service is counted towards your four roadside assistance service calls per member, per membership year, including the one 200 mile tow (for example, one instance of bicycle transportation service between 101-200 miles in length will be offered in lieu of an automobile tow of comparable length).

HOME LOCKOUT REIMBURSEMENT*

Each AAA Premier Member household is eligible to receive up to a \$100 reimbursement for home lockout assistance (one per membership household, per membership year).

EMERGENCY BREAKDOWN RENTAL CAR PROGRAM*

Premier members whose vehicle is inoperable after receiving breakdown service from AAA are eligible for a complimentary day's rental car. The rental may be compact to full-size.

Service must be provided by Hertz, AAA's preferred rental car provider, and arranged through AAA Idaho. This benefit is offered only at participating Hertz locations in the United States and Canada. The member is responsible for any additional days, upgrades, vehicle insurance, mileage and fuel, and any other charges, fees and taxes which may apply. Call 1-800-AAA-HELP (1-800-222-4357).

TRAVEL ASSISTANCE CONCIERGE SERVICE**

Services are available only during 'covered travel'.

As a AAA Premier Member, you have instant access to a host of travel services when traveling domestically or internationally. By calling the toll-free AAA Premier Services telephone number, you can obtain information such as:

- Restaurant and spa recommendations and services
- Gift basket and floral delivery
- Golf tee times and reservations (subject to availability)
- Event tickets
- Tour information
- Business services

The Premier Membership includes concierge services which are service benefits, not financial benefits. Any costs associated with services are paid by the member.

24-HOUR GLOBAL TRAVEL EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE**

Services are available only during 'covered travel'.

As a AAA Premier Member, you can rest easy every time you are traveling domestically or on an international vacation. If you have an emergency while 100 miles or more from your primary residence – within the United States or internationally – you may call for Emergency Travel and Medical Assistance 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.



This service provides access to such things as:

- Medical Referrals
- Lost Ticket and Baggage Assistance
- Emergency Airline and Hotel Reservation
- Legal referrals
- Money transfers

The Premier Membership includes access to emergency travel assistance which are service benefits, not financial benefits. Any costs associated with services are paid by the member.

TRAVEL INSURANCE TRIP INTERRUPTION* AND VEHICLE RETURN COVERAGE*

Covered person must be at least 100 driving miles from home when incident occurs.

AAA Premier Trip Interruption and Vehicle Return Coverage benefits provide members greater peace of mind when driving 100 miles or more from home. If your trip is delayed due to an Accident, mechanical breakdown, car theft, unexpected Illness or Injury, natural disasters or severe weather, you can be reimbursed up to \$1,500 for covered out-of-pocket expenses, including meals and Accommodations; and/or Substitute Transportation to continue your trip. You can be reimbursed up to \$500 to help you get your car back home if an unexpected Illness or Injury prevents you from completing your trip.

Insurance coverage is underwritten by BCS Insurance Company under Form no. 50.233B.

HERTZ #1 CLUB GOLD® MEMBERSHIP

AAA Premier Members receive a fee-waived Hertz #1 Club Gold® Membership which gets them on their way even faster:

- Speed and Expedited Service - At many of the world's busiest airports, there's no stopping at any counters. And, at more than 1,000 other locations around the world, simply go to the specially designated Gold counters, show your driver's license, pick up your keys, and you're on your way.
- Selection - Reserve a specific make and model on popular vehicles at major U.S. airport locations in select vacation locations.

Premier Members will continue to enjoy their Hertz #1 Club Gold® membership at no extra charge in subsequent years (this benefit is subject to change without notice).

DOMESTIC AIRLINE TICKET PROCESSING FEE DISCOUNT

AAA Premier Members will receive a lower processing fee when booking air tickets through the AAA Idaho Travel Agency. At least one of the travelers must be a Premier member. Limit to four travelers per booking.

COMPLIMENTARY PASSPORT PHOTOS

AAA Premier Members receive complimentary passport photos at select AAA Service Centers. One set (2 photos) per Premier member per year. In addition many travelers obtain extra photos for identification purposes, or for visa applications required by many foreign countries. Passport information and applications are available at most AAA Service Centers.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

You may include other members of your household in your membership for an additional fee. An Associate Membership provides AAA services to the Primary Member's spouse or one other adult household member residing at the same address and any unmarried children age 22 and under living at home (including those away at school).



FAMILY MEMBERSHIP

Now the whole family can enjoy AAA savings and security. That includes dependable roadside assistance for everyone—whether they're a driver or a passenger in someone else's car. You must have one Primary Membership and three or more associates to qualify for a Family Membership. This Family Membership cost does not include AAA Plus, Plus RV or Premier.

When you sign your first repair invoice at an Approved Auto Repair facility, you are entitled to a complimentary maintenance inspection, a written estimate, and a 12-month or 12,000-mile warranty for parts and labor. ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE DETAILS

AAA Idaho (“the Club”) reserves the right to limit service, not renew a membership, or cancel a membership on a prorated basis.

ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

Service applies to all licensed, four-wheeled motor-driven passenger vehicles, (including rental and commercial vehicles) if those services can be safely delivered with normal automobile servicing equipment, including sling, wheel lift devices, flatbed car carriers, and dollies.

Dual-wheel campers/motor homes are eligible for lockout, fuel delivery, and jump start services only. Dual-wheel unloaded pickup trucks are eligible for all services except tire service. Taxicabs, sprinter vans, box vans, and limousines are excluded from coverage.



BENEFITS FOR VEHICLES DO NOT INCLUDE

- More than one tow per disablement.
- Reimbursement for towing ordered by the police or other proper entity because a vehicle is illegally parked or impounded due to a violation of a state or local ordinance.
- Attaching or removing tire chains.
- Loss of traction due to weather conditions when the eligible vehicle is otherwise operable.
- Seasonal changing of studded or snow tires.
- Shoveling snow or extricating vehicles from snow in driveways or parking lots.
- Towing to or from junk yards or salvage lots.
- Rotating tires.
- Parts and tires.
- Service where we or our contractor deem a road is not safely passable due to snow or obstructions such as slides, fallen trees, flood, etc.
- Service to any vehicle that has become disabled, wrecked, or stuck if it was intentionally driven off or away from a normally traveled road, street, or driveway; such as onto a vacant lot, yard, field, creek, river bed, beach, logging or Forest Service road. Exception is made where there is a posted detour around a normally traveled roadway.

ELIGIBLE BICYCLES

Service applies to all bicycles and tandems, including rental bicycles and bicycle trailers, if service can be safely delivered using normal servicing equipment.

BENEFITS FOR BICYCLE SERVICE DO NOT INCLUDE

- Reimbursement for impounding ordered by the police or other proper entity because a bicycle was impounded due to a violation of a state or local ordinance.
- Service off of normally traveled roads or streets. If bicycle breakdown occurs off or away from a normally traveled road or street, such as on a field, creek, river bed or beach, or logging or Forest Service road, service will only be provided if the bicycle can be moved by the member to a normally traveled road.
- Service to unattended bicycles.
- Storage or repair costs.
- Parts and tires.
- More than one transportation per disablement.

- Cost of providing alternate transportation.
- Fatigue and physical inability to continue with ride. Exception may apply for an injury that occurred as a result of a bicycle accident.
- Rendering mechanical first aid or changing of a flat tire.
- Rendering service to break or cut a lock on a secured bicycle.
- Service where we or our contractor deem a road is not safely passable due to snow or obstructions such as slides, fallen trees, flood, etc.
- Accident Away From Home Expense, Trip Interruption and Vehicle Return, Emergency Breakdown Rental Car Program, and Theft Reward do not apply to bicycle coverage.

Since Bicycle Service is only provided in the AAA Oregon/Idaho coverage area, which includes Oregon and the southern 34 counties of Idaho, reimbursement is not available when service is provided outside the AAA Oregon/Idaho coverage area.

UNUSUAL OR EXTREME WEATHER OR ROAD CONDITIONS

Snow, unusual or extreme hot or cold weather, heavy rainfall, and unusually heavy traffic can sometimes cause service delays. Under these conditions, the Club reserves the right to delay some services until the extreme demand for service is over.

MEMBERSHIP CARD

The card can be used only by the person whose name is on the card. It is not transferable. If you cannot present a valid, current AAA card to the service driver, there will be a charge for the service.



PAYING BY CHECK

As a AAA member, you can use your personal check for up to \$250 at AAA service facilities to cover emergency repairs or emergency services not covered by your membership. A valid driver's license and membership card will be required for identification.

REIMBURSEMENT FOR ALTERNATE SERVICE

You will save by calling AAA and following the procedures listed in the benefits section of this guide before utilizing alternate service. AAA reserves the right to adjust refunds in accordance with AAA contract rates.

If you have followed these procedures and AAA service is not available, you may obtain your service and submit the original receipt to AAA within 60 days.

Reimbursements will be based on the prevailing commercial rate for the region where the vehicle was disabled. For lockout reimbursement, see information under Lockout Service. If you do not have your card, and membership cannot be verified, reimbursement will be provided at contract rates. In instances where the AAA contractor's access is restricted (toll roads and limited access highways), reimbursement will be provided.

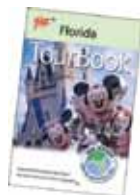

MEMBERSHIP EXPIRATION POLICY

Membership dues are billed annually. Updated membership cards for the new membership year (including an updated membership expiration date) are provided to you in advance with the first dues bill we send.

You should have your current membership card with you when requesting service. All membership services (including roadside assistance) will continue to be available to you during a grace period of 30 days after your membership expiration date. From 31 to 75 days past your membership expiration date you will be required to pay your renewal dues prior to receiving roadside assistance services. All services other than roadside assistance will continue to be available during a period of 75 days after your membership expiration date, even if we have not received your renewal dues. Your membership will be cancelled after 75 days past your membership expiration date unless your renewal dues are paid in full.

If you pay your renewal dues during the 75 day period after your expiration date, your new expiration date will be one year after your previous expiration date, and no new member enrollment fee will be required. If your membership has been cancelled, and you then later choose to reinstate your membership, you will be required to pay the new member enrollment fee as well as applicable membership dues. A new membership card and a new expiration date will be assigned at that time.

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOUR VEHICLE BREAKS DOWN

- 1. NOTE YOUR LOCATION.** Look for well-lighted areas and notice any landmarks such as service stations. Make a note of your intersection or, if on a highway, note the mile number or last exit number—you'll need to provide this information when you call for assistance.
- 2. ASSESS YOUR VEHICLE'S PROBLEM.** Is a warning indicator lit on your instrument panel? Did you hear any unusual noises? Did you notice any warning signs such as steering problems or steam coming out from under the hood?
- 3. PULL OFF THE ROAD.** Move to the right shoulder as far from traffic as possible and stay with your vehicle unless it is not safe. If your vehicle is inoperable and you are unable to pull off the road, do not try to push it to a safe location. If you are uncertain about your safety, do not stay in your vehicle; watch for traffic and proceed carefully to a safer location. Never stand directly behind or in front of your vehicle as other motorists may have trouble seeing you.
- 4. ALERT OTHER MOTORISTS.** Make sure your vehicle is visible to approaching motorists. Turn on your emergency flashers, especially at night. Place road flares behind your vehicle unless you see or smell gasoline. Raise your hood and tie a colored handkerchief to your antenna or door.
- 5. COMMUNICATE YOUR SITUATION.** Once you are in a safe location, notify others of your vehicle breakdown. If you have a cell phone, call 1-800-AAA-HELP (1-800-222-4357). If you're safely out of traffic, make the call from inside your vehicle. Be prepared to provide your phone number, location, a description of your vehicle (including color, model, year, and license plate number) and your AAA membership number. If you do not have a cell phone, consider whether you can walk safely to a pay phone or emergency call box. If there is no telephone available within safe walking distance, try to get the attention of law enforcement officers. If a stranger stops to offer help, ask the person to call for assistance.
- 6. REMAIN WITH YOUR VEHICLE.** If you are able to pull away from traffic, it is generally safer to remain with your vehicle until a police officer or tow truck operator arrives. Do not accept a ride from a stranger.
- 7. WHAT TO EXPECT FROM ROADSIDE ASSISTANCE.** Make sure that the vehicle and driver offering assistance are the same as those you requested. Roadside assistance operators can often provide fuel, change a flat tire, or boost a battery. If the problem is more serious, your vehicle may need to be towed. You may ride with the service provider.
Remember that it's your responsibility to understand what services your roadside assistance will cover.
